Please note that in all language courses students are required to attend at least 75 % of all lectures in order to be permitted to take the exam. According to this 75 % rule, for subjects worth 2 ECTS, a student can be absent only three times* during the semester and for subjects worth 4 ECTS, a student can be absent only six times*.

*One time = 2 Teaching Units = 2 x 45 minutes


Masterseminar
